### CONSTRUCTION FINISHING LINE IN SIGHT

With our project now well into the final eight months of its construction programme, it is exciting to see The Langston's towers reveal their curvilinear facades.

By the end of this month, we should see our three towers reach Level 24 (of 29 levels), Level 23 (of 24 levels) and Level 18 (of 19 levels) respectively. Meanwhile, façade installation is ongoing, as is internal apartment fitout, including the installation of fixtures and finishes and the connection of key services such as electricity and plumbing.

At this point, we are expecting to 'top out' (reach the apex) of the 29-storey Langston Tower by the end of March 2021, which we will celebrate with a traditional 'topping out' ceremony – keep an eye out for more details on this in our next newsletter.

### NEW POOL FACILITY TO BECOME RECREATION HUB FOR EPPING

City of Parramatta Council has released new images of the proposed \$22.8 million upgrade of Epping Pool, which is set to feature two new pools as part of a new and improved recreational space within Dence Park, conveniently located within a short walk of The Langston.

Nestled in bushland, the revamped two-storey facility will include an expanded eight-lane, 50-metre outdoor pool, plus a new 25-metre indoor pool, additional change rooms, an accessible walkway from the car park, a lift, and more green spaces.

The Epping Pool Draft Concept Plan has been prepared as part of the Dence Park Masterplan, and is being co-funded by the NSW Government.

Construction is expected to commence next year, with the upgrade scheduled for completion in late 2023.
